- 1. Persons or institutions to be honored can be nominated by a national association or by the WRRC-Presidium.
- 2. Honorations are to be decided by the WRRC-Presidium by simple majority.
- 3. Honorations as the following are possible:

1	Honorary President	Outstanding merits
2	Honorary membership pursuant to. § 4 clause 5 of the Statutes	Merits as to the interests of WRRC or Rock'n'Roll competitive dancing
3	Medal in Platinum	Outstanding achievements in sport for athletes and trainers
4	Medal in Gold	At least 10 years of outstanding merits or sportive performance
5	Medal in Silver	At least 5 years of particular commitment or sportive performance
6	Medal in Bronze	Commitment or support for WRRC

3.1 The honorary title of an honorary Chairman can only be awarded by the outgoing Chairman or Vice Chairman.

All other honorary titles or honorary memberships can be awarded to organizers, sponsors, trainers, actives and functionaries as well as members of the Executive Board, sector commissioners, members of the medical committee, supervisors, observers, WRRC-Judges, persons in charge of the minutes or technicians.

4. Special awards can also be decided and awarded by the WRRC-Presidium.
