1. GENERAL RULES

1.1 Persons or institutions to be honored can be nominated by a national association or by the WRRC-Presidium.

1.2 Honorations and Hall of Fame integration are to be decided by the WRRC Presidium by simple majority

The study of proposals and the attributions will be carried out Presidium during the first WRRC Presidium Meeting of each year

2. WRRC HONORATIONS

2.1 Honorations as the following are possible:

Nr.	Name	Prerequisites
1	Honorary President	Outstanding merits
2	Honorary membership pursuant to. § 4 clause 5 of the Statutes	Merits as to the interests of WRRC or Rock'n'Roll competitive dancing
3	Medal in Diamond	Extraordinary contribution in development of Acrobatic Rock'n'Roll and Boogie Woogie
4	Medal in Ruby	At least 40 years of outstanding merits
5	Medal in Platinum	Outstanding achievements in sport for athletes and trainers
6	Medal in Gold	At least 10 years of outstanding merits or sportive performance
7	Medal in Silver	At least 5 years of particular commitment or sportive performance
8	Medal in Bronze	Commitment or support for WRRC

2.2 The honorary title of an honorary President can only be awarded to the outgoing President.

All other honorary titles or honorary memberships can be awarded to organizers, sponsors, trainers, actives and functionaries as well as members of the Presidium, sector commissioners, members of the medical committee, supervisors, observers, WRRC-Judges, persons in charge of the minutes or technicians.

2.3 Sportive performances required to become a WRRC medalist as dancer

- Medal in Platinum, at least
 - 2 times The World Games winner
 - or 1 time The World Games winner + 4 times World Champion RR MCFS
 - or 5 times World Champion in BW MC or in RRMCFs
- Medal in Gold, at least
 - 1 time The World Games winner + 1 times World Champion RR MCFS
 - or 3 times World Champion in BW MC or in RRMCFs
- Medal in Silver, at least
 - 2 times World Champion in BW MC or RR MCFS

2.4. Special awards can also be decided and awarded by the WRRC-Presidium.
