INTRODUCTION

World Rock and Roll Confederation (WRRC) highly values individuals and enterprises privacy. The Privacy Policy is the collection of our statements regarding the data protection and privacy during the procession and use of information related to the services offered at www.wrrc.org and www.wrrc.dance websites, newsletters, registration systems and other digital properties created and managed by the WRRC (collectively the “Services”).

Our Privacy Policy is also committed to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679) compliance having members from the EU and being active on EU territory, and to the Swiss legislation.

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time while the last update date is always indicated at top of the document. We will inform you in advance about these changes but we also encourage you to check this document regularly by your own.

Your continued use of the Services after the entry into force of the revised Privacy Policy will constitute your confirmation of your reading and understanding of such changes.

THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Most of the content at WRRC online and digital Services is open for everyone and does not require registration. However, certain personalization options, transactions or services (such as e-commerce, newsletters, professional services or event registration services) require that you register with us and provide certain information about you. Unless otherwise indicated, registration and other Services is open only to users who are 14 or above. Children under the age of 14 should upload a parent or guardian approval.

1. Information you provide

You may provide us with information including personal one which might include your name, age, sex, address, email address, IP address and other such as login and password when using various Services such as creating an account, registration to the events, online shopping, subscription to media alerts as well as when you contact us or request a service from us.

While uploading the materials (visual, video, documents etc.) on the WRRC website and while using other WRRC online Services you provide us with the full and constant right to use them lawfully and according to this Privacy Policy.

Some information may also be collected automatically even from non-registered users through cookies, pixels and similar technologies.

2. Purpose of the collection

The information we collect from you is needed in order to identify you as a registered person and categorize you as an athlete/coach/judge/sponsor or other so that we can lawfully address you with the information you need; to answer your queries; to improve the performance of digital services; to collect analytics and statistics; to provide and measure advertising of various products and services that reflect your use of the website and Services; to enable you to share the content and track the sharing statistics; to facilitate your use of the Services; to provide you with a personalized experience based on your preferences and choices; to organize relevant communication.

3. Basic principles for the collection

Processing is only allowed if a person affected freely gave their consent, for example, when registering on a website.

Personal data may be collected and processed for lawful purposes only.

The respective purpose must be defined before the time at which the data is collected. Processing for a purpose other than the one defined before the data was collected is permitted in exceptional circumstances only if the person affected consents to the processing or if stipulated by law.

Personal data is to be collected directly from the person affected. Otherwise, the person affected must be at least informed of which types of personal data will be collected, processed, and/or used, and for which specific purposes.

Personal data must be accurate at all times and corrected where necessary. Personal data may be retained only for as long as is absolutely necessary for the purposes specified or other legal requirements. Thereafter, personal data must be deleted or anonymized.

THE INFORMATION WE SHARE

We may share your information with the third parties if the provision of the Services requested by you require such share. If it happens, the purposes and the use of the information is always lawful and only for the purposes outlined in this Policy.

As the provision of the Services is connected with work of various specialists, we may also share your information with technical and IT operators, marketing professionals, analytics and measurement services, email and push notification services, third party social media and web services with whom we cooperate on advertising and promotion campaigns.

All above-mentioned third parties agree to use the information strictly according to this Policy too.

LEGAL DISCLOSURE

The WRRC will transfer personal data to governmental agencies only on the basis of applicable law. We will inform the person affected of such a request from the governmental agencies.

WITHDRAWAL AND RECTIFICATION

It is possible for you to change and review the information given at any time. Besides, you can freely withdraw your consent to the use of the Services and stop using them.

DATA SECURITY

We take steps to ensure that the info is treated securely.

However, we would like to draw your attention to the following: all data is transmitted normally over the Internet, and this can never be guaranteed to be 100% secure. While sending your information you do it at your own risk.

We are also not responsible for any privacy regulations operated by other websites and online resources the links to which you may find at WRRC online properties while using the Services.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER

As a rule, the information we collect will be processed in the EU but due to the fact that some of our IT and technical operators are located outside the EU (for example in the USA, Russia, Switzerland) they will have an access to your information there too. If you use our Services outside the EU, it also means that your data protection may be affected by local legislation. These countries may not have similar data protection laws. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing.
